

European Congress of Cytology

Rules & Regulations

1. General provisions

- a. These regulations define the rules of participation in the '**European Congress of Cytology**', hereinafter referred to as *Congress*.
- b. The Congress will be held on **3-6 October 2021** in the Wrocław Congress Center (Centennial Hall complex), located at Wystawowa Street 1, 51-618 Wrocław, Poland.
- c. The Organizers of the Congress are: the European Federation of Cytology Societies, The Polish Society of Pathologists and Fundacja Uniwersytetu Medycznego we Wrocławiu (Wrocław Medical University Foundation).
- d. A Participant of the Congress is a person who has reported his/her participation in the Congress on the terms set out in these Regulations.
- e. The schedule and program of the Congress are available at <https://www.cytology2021.eu/>
- f. The official language of the Congress is English.
- g. The Organizers are eligible to make changes to the program without providing reasons.
- h. The Rules and Regulations are available at the official Congress website.

2. Rules for participation

- a. Participation in the Congress requires a fee. To be able to participate in the Congress, the Participants are obliged to fill in the registration form and pay the accreditation fee. The accreditation fee depends on the registration type and time of the registration. The tables with prices (Registration Fees are in EUR or PLN and incl. VAT) are available on the website and below. The bank account number is given below. Please make sure the payment is received within **14 days** of your online registration. Filling in one registration form and paying one fee enables one person to take part in the Congress.

- b. Students and residents are required to send a certificate to ecc2021@convention.wroclaw.pl proving their student/resident status. Valid student card confirming your status and copy of your current tuition in graduate studies, master studies, mentoring of your doctoral thesis or fellow accreditation. Documents mentioned above will be immediately deleted after verification of the student/resident status.
- c. Cytotechnologists have to write the occupation number during the registration process. It is needed to use the cytotechnologist discount.
- d. There is no possibility to participate only in workshops or accompanying events without registering for Congress day(s) and paying Congress fee.

- f. The registration for Participants of the Congress can be made only through the registration form available online on the official Congress website: <https://www.cytology2021.eu/>
- g. During the registration, an applicant should enter the following data into the registration form:
- name and surname, title, e-mail address, phone number, name of the represented institution or university, occupation number (cytotechnologists), food preferences,
 - data required for invoicing purposes,
 - consent for the processing of personal data by the Organiser in compliance with the enclosed declarations.
- h. Completion of registration is confirmed by an e-mail sent to the e-mail address indicated in the form. The message also includes payment information.
- i. In order to any data changes, please contact the Organiser via e-mail: ecc2021@convention.wroclaw.pl
- j. Registration fee includes:

- Admission to the ECC 2021 Congress,
 - Congress materials including delegate badge (Participant is obliged to carry the personal Badge during each day of the Congress). Only a person who demonstrates the personal Badge will be able to attend the congress and get permission to the Congress venue. Such persons will be required to leave the Facility immediately at the request of the Organiser's representatives) and a Congress bag,
 - Opening Ceremony – 3rd October 2021 (attending in the first day of the Congress is a must),
 - Access to the exhibition area,
 - Free internet access in designated areas,
 - Lunch and coffee break.
- k. If you want to use **Early Bird** price you have to register and pay **maximum till August, 14 2021**.
- l. Due to the limited availability of places, the Organizer reserves the right to close the registration if the maximum number of Participants has been reached.
- m. Each workshop has limited number of participants. For workshops taking place in Multifunctional Hall - 60 participants, for workshops in Room E - 30 participants and for workshops in Room F - 30 participants. Participation depends on the order in which applications were received. If the limit will be reached, please send your interest by e-mail, you will be placed on the substitute list. A fee must be paid to confirm the reservation of participation in the workshop.
- n. Participation in Presidential Dinner is limited for the first 60 registered participants (exl. invited guests).
- o. The Payer (the recipient of the invoice) is the entity indicated by the Participant in the registration form.
- p. By paying the fee the Participant authorizes the Organizer to issue a VAT invoice and send it only to the e-mail address provided in the registration form.
- q. Registration fees **are not refundable**.
- r. No payment for participation in the Congress on the date specified by the Organizer entitles the Organizer to cancel the participation application, without incurring any liability for damages.

3. Abstracts and e-poster sessions

- a. Only the registered person can send an abstract via the abstract system. b. Important dates:

October, 2020	Abstract submission opens
June, 2021	Deadline for abstract submission
July, 2021	Notification of results
August, 2021	Deadline for payment for registration of accepted abstracts' authors (14 days after notification)

c. General rules:

- Abstracts must be sent through the online platform – link to the abstract system will be sent after participant registration.
- During the abstract submission process, presenting authors must be clearly identified providing contact details (email required).
- Author(s) must select the topic (list of topics is presented on congress website) that best suits their paper. Each abstract must include a correct description of **objectives**, **material** and **methods**, **results** and **conclusions** so that the Scientific Committee of the Congress can make a correct review.
- An abstract cannot exceed in any case the 300 words. This does not include the abstract title, authors and their affiliations and references. Larger abstracts will not be admitted.
- One graph, table or diagram is allowed to be included in the abstract.
- • A maximum of 3 abstracts can be submitted by the same first author.
- All abstracts will be reviewed by at least two members of the Congress Scientific Committee. The final consideration will be of the Congress Scientific Committee.
- In order to have the abstracts included in the final program, all presenting authors must register for the Congress before August, 2021.
- For accepted abstracts, the presenting authors are required to be in attendance at their oral/poster sessions (allocated by the Congress organization).

- All abstracts should be **submitted and presented in English** by using clear language, avoiding complex characters or formulas difficult to understand.
- Participants may not express theses or views inciting hatred or discrimination against any person based on race, culture, ethnicity, religion, belief or gender.
- The authors are authorized by their co-authors to enter into these arrangements.
- The authors warrant that they secure the right to reproduce any material that has already been published or copyrighted elsewhere.

4. Final Provisions

- a. The Organizer is not responsible for Participants' belongings that have been lost, damaged or stolen during the Congress.
- b. Each Participant of the Congress bears full financial responsibility for the damage s/he has caused during the Congress.
- c. The Organizer is not liable for damage caused to the Participant as a consequence of the force majeure. Force majeure is understood as an event or combination of events or circumstances, independent of the Organizer, which generally hamper or prevent the Organizer's obligations and which the Organizer could not have predicted or prevented or overcome by acting with due diligence.
- d. The Organizer reserves the right to change the date or cancel the Congress for reasons beyond their control. If the event of the Congress being cancelled, the Organizer will refund the entire fee paid by the Participant to the bank account which was used to make a payment.
- e. The Organizer does not cover the costs of transport, insurance and accommodation for Participants of the Congress.
- f. The Organizer has the exclusive right to a binding interpretation of the Regulations.
- g. These Regulations shall enter into force upon acceptance.
